

1. The pitch count rules shall apply to the Farm, AAA, Major, Junior, Senior, and Big League divisions of Baseball only.
2. Alderwood Little League shall strictly follow the pitch count limitations as set forth in the 2012 rulebook issued by Little League Baseball, Inc.
3. The Home Team shall be designated as the official scorekeeper for all games and shall be the official record for all pitch counts. The official scorebook shall be maintained in the home team dugout, if possible.
4. Pitch count shall be recorded in the scorebook at the end of each inning.
5. Managers are encouraged to confirm pitch counts at the end of each inning with the official scorekeeper.
6. Any discrepancies or disagreements shall be resolved before the start of the next inning of play. The Home Plate Umpire shall have the final say in resolving all discrepancies, and said decision shall be final.
7. All Farm, AAA and Major Division managers shall report their pitch counts to the Alderwood Little League headquarters into the official pitch count database. Major Managers should be in agreement on the counts submitted after each game. Junior and above managers shall report pitch counts to their respective division coordinators and District in a manner requested and approved by the Alderwood Little League Board of Directors. Failure to promptly report pitch counts may be subject to disciplinary action.
8. Any Manager, who intentionally or otherwise violates the pitch count rules, shall be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in the official rulebook of Little League Baseball, Inc. The Alderwood Little League Board of Directors, reserves the right to invoke a greater penalty, at its sole discretion.
